

MINUTES OF  
GALENA CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
JANUARY 18, 1983

CALL TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Galena was called to order by Mayor Thomas L. Wade, at 7:00 P.M., in the Council Chambers on Tuesday, January 18, 1983.

ROLL CALL:

Roll Call indicated the following councilmembers present: Adams, Hayes, Means, Little, Murray, J. Watkins, R. Watkins, Allen. Absent: Bankson, Shallenburger.

MINUTES:

Moved by Little, seconded by Adams, to approve and place on file the minutes of the Regular Meeting on January 4, 1983. Motion declared carried. (Abstained - 3 - Murray, Hayes, J. Watkins)

CONDEMNATIONS:

City Superintendent is to go ahead and remove the house at 825 E. 7th belonging to Myrtle Lawing as time is up on condemnation.

Moved by Means, seconded by Murray, to approve Resolution 83-1 setting a hearing for March 15, 1983, to show cause why house at 1201 Madison should be condemned. The house belongs to Helen Yount. Motion declared carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Moved by Little, seconded by Hayes, to recess to an executive session at 7:26 P.M. for 15 minutes to discuss the salary increase Ordinance. Motion declared carried. (1 Nay - Allen)

The Council approved for Mrs. Ruth Eldridge to use the HUD Office 1 day a week.

Mayor Wade left the meeting at 7:50 P.M. and President of Council, Donald Means, presided over the remainder of the meeting.

SALARY INCREASE  
ORDINANCE:

Moved by R. Watkins, seconded by J. Watkins, to send the Payroll ordinance back to the Finance Committee for further study. Motion declared carried.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS:

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to have the City Clerk's Office (Howard & Barbara) grant normal extensions on delinquent accounts, the Council will conduct the actual Hearings for unusual extensions that the City Clerk's Office cannot extend. Motion declared carried.

920 LOADER TIRES:

Moved by Little, seconded by Adams, to purchase 4 - 16-ply tires for the 920 Loader from Burggraf Tire at a cost of \$460, to be paid from Water, Sewer, Street, & Special Highway Funds. Motion declared carried.

CAVE-IN:

City Superintendent, Howard Jarvis, is to talk to School Superintendent, Mr. Russell, and see if they will help with fuel expense for filling the cave-
