

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, COUNCIL MEETING, JANUARY 20, 1970

The Council of the City of Galena, Kansas, met in regular session in the council room, city building, at 7:00 p.m., January 20, 1970.

Present: Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett.

Absent: Mayor Frank P. Dillon and Councilmen Martin, Sturgis, and Kaehler.

Presiding: Council President Pittman.

Councilman Watkins moved, seconded by Councilman Tackett, that the reading of the minutes dated and presented by copy to the Governing Body January 6, 1970, be dispensed and placed on file. Motion carried by a show of hands.

Councilman Pittman introduced Ordinance No. 897 and entitled:

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FEDERAL AID FOR SEWER FACILITIES IN GALENA, KANSAS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY NOTES FOR PAYMENT OF CITY OBLIGATIONS BEFORE FINAL PAYMENT ON FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilmen Tackett and Noe, that ordinance Numbered 897 be placed on roll call for adoption. On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett; Nays - none. Carried.

Councilman Noe moved, seconded by Councilman Pittman, that a travel expense allowance not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per trip be set up in a revolving fund to defray the Mayor's or an authorized officials expenses in conjunction with City business, i.e., sewer project. On roll call the motion carried as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett; Nays - none.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Noe, that a cereal malt beverage license be issued to Bill R. Murray dba Bill's Pool Hall, 516 Main, as the license issued to Joe Mallatt dba Joe's Place had been surrendered and Mr. Mallatt was no longer in business. Motion carried by roll call vote as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, and Bogle; Nays - Councilman Tackett.

Councilman Pittman read in full the contract submitted by Barrett & Cusack, Baxter Springs, Kansas, for auditing the City's 1969 books and preparing the budget for 1971, Certified Public Account in charge of audit, \$8.50 an hour, Assistants \$6.00 an hour, typists \$4.00 an hour, plus actual expenditure for travel and subsistence. Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Tackett, that the foregoing mentioned contract be approved and accepted by roll call vote. On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett; Nays - none. Motion carried.

Councilman Watkins moved, seconded by Councilman Brown, that Ordinance No. 604, an ordinance making payment for certain claims, be placed on roll call for adoption. The meeting being public, the ordinance was discussed, and on roll call the vote was: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett; Nays - none. A statutory majority of the councilmen having voted for passage of the ordinance, it was declared passed.

Councilman Tackett moved, seconded by Councilman Watkins, that The Empire District Electric Company be contacted and request that a street light be installed at 24th and Galena Avenue. On roll call the vote was: Yeas - Councilmen Pittman, Brown, Kitch, Noe, Watkins, Bogle, and Tackett; Nays - none.

Van Bradshaw was present and lodged a complaint against dogs running at large and requested review of the matter. The matter was tabled and no action taken on the matter.

On motion duly made and seconded the meeting was adjourned until the next regular session.
