MINUTES OF GALENA CITY COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 1987

CALL TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the City Council was called to order Tuesday, March 3, 1987 in the Council Chambers at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor John Stephenson presiding.

Bud Sills spoke concerning replacement costs of stoplights when damaged or torn down due to accidents. He suggested that the charge to the responsible person might be increased from \$460.00 to \$750.00.

Moved by Kay Kay, seconded by Anderson to contact State to request financial aid in relocating stoplights at 7th & Main Streets. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Kay Kay, seconded by Watkins to allow 1 wk. pay in lieu of vacation for Garry Abram. Motion declared carried.

Councilman Allen requested the Fire Department be allowed to use the municipal building and grounds for Galena Days. Also that downtown Main Street be closed to traffic on Saturday for the flea market.

Moved by Watkins, seconded by Jarvis to allow a \$25.00/month pay increase for Melissa LaTurner, the day shift dispatcher. Motion declared carried. Nay: Allen, King. Abstain: LaTurner

Citizen John Link was present to comment on cleanup procedures in the city and to lodge complaint on a certain piece of property near his residence. He was advised on status of both items.
