

MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD MARCH 21, 1978.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT:

WARD, REED, BANKSON, DAVIES, WADE, ALLEN, AVICOLA, MEANS.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT:

HART, HOPKINS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT THE MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD MARCH 7, 1978, BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY ADVISED CITY CLERK TO CALL THOMAS CUSACK AND SEE WHEN HE COULD START THE AUDIT.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY BANKSON TO GIVE JUANITA SCOTT ONE WEEK PAY IN LIEU OF VACATION. MOTION CARRIED.

EIGHT BIDS WERE SUBMITTED FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE OLD STANDPIPE ON WOOD STREET. THE COUNCIL TURNED THE MATTER OVER TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR REVIEW OF FUNDS AND THEN TO REPORT BACK FOR POSSIBLE AWARD OF CONTRACT.

IT WAS ADVISED NOT TO TAKE ANY ACTION AT THIS TIME ON THE ELMER FOX MATTER ON THE ADVICE OF THE STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

MOTION WAS MADE BY REED AND SECONDED BY BANKSON TO ALLOW \$150.00 FOR EXPENSES OF THE CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR TO ATTEND A SEMINAR FOR THREE DAYS IN HAYES, KANSAS, TO BE PAID FROM GENERAL FUND. MOTION CARRIED. 2(NAYS)ALLEN, MEANS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE TO RETAIN LEROY LAKE ON THE CITY AS AN EMPLOYEE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY WADE TO ACCEPT THE BID OF OTIS THOMAS TO DO THE LPW AUDIT WITH THE PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$960.00. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WADE AND SECONDED BY MEANS THAT PREPARATION OF BASE WORK ON ROADS 21st, 22nd, AND 23rd BE STARTED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WARD AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY BE PAID \$25.00 FOR EXPENSES FOR HIS TRIP TO TOPEKA ON CITY BUSINESS. MOTION CARRIED. (NAY)MEANS, (1)ABSTAINED-REED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WADE AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT THE PRIMARY ELECTION EXPENSES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$654.25 BE PAID ON PURCHASE ORDER NUMBER 951. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT THE PURCHASE OF NEW SEAT COVERS FOR THE NEW POLICE CAR BE DENIED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WADE AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO PURCHASE A KETCH-ALL POLE FOR THE STOCK MARSHAL ON PURCHASE ORDER NUMBER 930 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45.60. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO ALLOW REX GANDY TO BUY MATERIALS AS NEEDED FOR 800' OF PIPE FOR THE WATER MAIN ON EAST 23rd. MOTION CARRIED. (1) ABSTAINED-MEANS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA FOR ALL DEPARTMENTS TO TURN IN TELEPHONE CALLS MADE AT THE END OF THE MONTH. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY BANKSON TO ALLOW MEALS FOR ELECTION WORKERS. MOTION CARRIED. 1(NAY)REED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WADE AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT TWO TENNIS NETS BE PURCHASED FROM VARSITY SCHOOL SUPPLY AT A COST OF \$90.95 EACH TO BE PAID FROM PARK FUND. MOTION CARRIED.

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MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE THAT MARY ANN LITTLE, KAREN ROBERSON, AND THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE ATTEND A CONFERENCE AT CHANUTE, MARCH 23, WITH EXPENSES PAID.

MARY ANN LITTLE ANNOUNCED A MEETING ON MARCH 28, IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE WITH A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE FARM AND HOME ADMINISTRATION AND A MEETING MARCH 31, AT THE NEW CITY BUILDING WITH A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE LPW PROGRAM FOR ANY INTERESTED PERSONS CARING TO GO.

THE CITY PARK COMMITTEE WAS INSTRUCTED TO MEET WITH REX GANDY TO LOOK INTO POSSIBLE SHADING OF THE PATIO AREA OF THE CITY POOL.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE THAT SPECIALTY TOOL AND ENGINEERING MACHINE COMPANY THREAD SIX PIPES FOR THE NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING AT A COST OF \$40.00 TO BE PAID FOR OUT OF THE POLICE FUND. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE THAT C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 78-6 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,497.96 AND PAYROLL ORDINANCE 78-6 AND APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE 78-6 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,215.80 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED. (1)ABSTAINED MEANS.
