

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JUNE 1, 1976.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT:

AVICOLA, BANKSON, BOGLE, HANSBRAUGH, MESSER, MURRAY, WARD, MANN, LEONARD.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT:

DAVIES

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY MESSER THAT THE MINUTES OF MEETING HELD MAY 17 AND MAY 25 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY MADE THE FOLLOWING COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS TO THE TWO NEW COUNCIL MEMBERS. COUNCILMAN CHARLES MANN WAS APPOINTED TO THE FIRE, INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT, AND WATER COMMITTEES. COUNCILMAN HAL LEONARD WAS APPOINTED TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, POLICE AND STREET COMMITTEES.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH THAT THE POLICE REPORT FOR MAY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,563.00 BE ACCEPTED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY MESSER AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT A DEAD END STREET SIGN BE INSTALLED AT 8TH AND MINERAL. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY MESSER AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT ORVILLE EPPERSON BE GRANTED A TWO WEEKS VACATION STARTING JUNE 4, 1976. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT ORDINANCE #983 ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS BE ADOPTED. MOTION FAILED --HANSBRAUGH, BOGLE, AND WARD VOTED IN FAVOR. MANN, LEONARD, MESSER, MURRAY AND BANKSON OPPOSED WITH AVICOLA ABSTAINING.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 76-11 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$46,297.44 AND PAYROLL ORDINANCE 76-12 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,543.03 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY MESSER TO PLACE A NOTICE IN THE LOCAL NEWS PAPER THAT THE CITY IS ACCEPTING BIDS FOR MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND BIDS MUST BE IN BY JUNE 15. MOTION CARRIED.

CITY ATTORNEY GEORGE HERRELSON READ A NOTICE FROM HELEN YOUNT IN THE CASE OF RONALD DARNABY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,774.14 FOR DAMAGES OCCURED IN A AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENT.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT THE NOTICE BE REJECTED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT THE HOURLY EMPLOYEES BE CUT TO A THREE DAY WORK WEEK AND BE DIVIDED SO HALF CAN WORK FIRST PART OF WEEK AND HALF SECOND PART OF WEEK, EFFECTIVE JUNE 11, 1976. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT ONLY CITY VEHICLES AND FIRE CHIEF BE ALLOWED TO USE GAS FROM CITY PUMPS. MOTION FAILED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT CHIEF OF POLICE BE ALLOTTED 10 GALS. OF GAS PER WEEK IN HIS OWN VEHICLE FOR WEEK END DUTY. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY MESSER THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
