MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY WARD THAT THE MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD JUNE 6 AND SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING HELD JUNE 7 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY ASKED THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE TO MEET WITH LLOYD MYERS, CITY BUILDING INSPECTOR TO CONSIDER WORKING FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT IN ADDITION TO PRESENT WORK ON INSPECTION OF REHABILIATION HOUSES AND BRING TO NEXT COUNCIL MEETING.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HOPKINS AND SECONDED BY DAVIES TO PERMIT PRIVATE SWIMMING PARTIES AT THE CITY SWIMMING POOL AT A COST OF \$10.00 PLUS \$10.00 LIFE GUARD SALARY IF THIS DOES NOT CONFLICT WITH REGULAR POOL HOURS. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY HOPKINS TO PURCHASE 5,000-6,000 GALLONS OF ROAD OIL AT A COST OF .33 PER GALLON FROM HYDRO-CARBON SPECIALTIES TO BE PAID FROM SPECIAL HIGHWAY FUND. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY MURRAY AND SECONDED BY BANKSON TO PURCHASE MATERIAL FOR SEWER ON 22ND STREET NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000.00 TO BE PAID FROM REVENUE SHARING. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY MURRAY TO WITHDRAW TERMINATION NOTICE OF CONTRACT WITH MILLER HAULING SERVICE. MOTION CARRIED. (1) NAY (1) ABSTAINED
