MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF JULY 3, 1972.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING HELD JUNE 20, 1970, WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BROWN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED. 491

DISCUSSION WAS HELD PERTAINING TO DOANE'S PRODUCTS COMPANY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI. IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT THEY HAD AGREED TO GIVE A \$100.00 HOOK-UP FEE AND A \$100.00 A MONTH MAINTENANCE FEE. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON THAT DOANE'S PRODUCT COMPANY PAY \$100.00 HOOK-UP FEE PLUS \$50.00 PER MONTH MAINTENANCE FEE SINCE THEY HAD AGREED TO PUMP OVER 14.000 GALLONS OF WATER PER DAY INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM WHICH WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO THE CITY, AS THE LAGOONS ARE IN BAD NEED OF A HIGH WATER LEVEL. MOTION CARRIED.

APPLICATION FOR CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE FOR ARKLE WALTON AT 2101 MAIN WAS PRE-SENTED TO THE COUNCIL. CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE TO BE SOLD IN UNOPEN CONTAINERS, NOT TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN WILLIAMS AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON THAT THE LICENSE BE ISSUED. MOTION CARRIED.

APPLICATION FOR CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE TO BILL R. MURRAY, 7TH & ELM, KNOWN AS BILL'S BAIT AND BEER WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL. A LICENSE FEE OF \$50.00 HAS BEEN PAID WHICH ALLOWS BEER TO BE SOLD IN UNOPENED CONTAINERS. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCIL-MAN WASHOM AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH THAT THE LICENSE BE ISSUED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN WILLIAMS AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN WASHOM THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY DRAW UP AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT MANAGER OF THE SWIMMING POOL AND GIVING THE \$100.00 A MONTH TO THE MANAGER. MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCILMAN KAEHLER REPORTED TO THE COUNCIL PERTAINING TO THE INDUSTRIAL PARK AND INFORMED THEM THAT MR. FOX HAD AGREED ON THE PROGRESS DONE BY THE CITY AND THAT THE CITY SHOULD RECEIVE SHORTLY \$1250.00 ON A MATCHING FORM BASIS FROM CHEROKEE COUNTY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN WASHOM AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH THAT THE CITY PURCHASE A USED TIRE CHANGER, GREASE GUN, SPARK PLUG CLEANER, AND SO FORTH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200.00 FROM BILL MURRAY, TO BE PAID EQUALLY FROM THE WATER, STREET, AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS. MOTION CARRIED.

IT WAS POINTED OUT THERE HAD BEEN SOME CONFUSION PERTAINING TO MOBILE HOME PERMITS. TO CLARIFY THIS, THE PEOPLE SHOULD RECEIVE A PERMIT FROM THE CLERK'S OFFICE AND SOME MEMBER FROM THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION SHALL PICK UP THE APPLICATION. THERE SHALL BE NO MOBILE HOMES PARKED ON ANY LOT WITHOUT FIRST GETTING THE PERMISSION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN WILLIAMS AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH THAT A MOBILE HOME OF JEFFERIES ON E. 17TH STREET BE APPROVED CONTINGENT ON THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON THAT A STOP SIGN BE INSTALLED AT 8TH & DEWEY. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN KAEHLER AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH THAT EIGHTEEN STOP SIGNS BE PURCHASED, NOT TO EXCEED \$180.00, AND CITY MARSHALL KARR WAS TO INVESTIGATE PRICES. MOTION CARRIED.

THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE'S REPORT FOR JUNE, 1972, WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL. TOTAL FINES FOR THE MONTH WAS \$1885.00. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND

ORDINANCE #677 WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL ALLOWING CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY OF GALENA IN THE AMOUNTS AS FOLLOWS: REGULAR, \$1,685.09, PAYROLL, \$5,110.33, SEWER, \$816.92, FOR A TOTAL OF \$7612.34. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BROWN AND SECONDED BY COUNCIL-MAN HANSBRAUGH THAT ORD. #677 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCIIMAN WILLIAMS AND SECONDED BY COUNCIIMAN WASHOM THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED BY STANDING.
