

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 2, 1973.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCILMEN PRESENT:

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING, HELD SEPTEMBER 18, 1973, WERE PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN JAY THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BOGLE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON THAT A 7' SICKLE BAR FROM THE CHETOPA IMPLEMENT COMPANY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$325, BE INSTALLED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWN THAT 5,600 GALLONS OF MC ROAD OIL BE PURCHASED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BOGLE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BAILEY THAT THE CITY ENTER INTO A CONTRACT ON THE MATTER OF CLEARING THE CITY DUMP TWICE A WEEK, WITH ELMONT AND MONTY MATTISON. THIS CONTRACT TO BE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100 PER MONTH. MOTION CARRIED.

DISCUSSION WAS HELD PERTAINING TO THE RENTING OF THE SCOUT HOUSE AT SCHERMERHORN PARK. IT WAS GENERALLY AGREED AMONG THE COUNCILMEN THAT THIS SHOULD NOT BE DONE.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BOGLE THAT THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #708 BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE PAYMENT OF \$275 TO DAN WILLIAMS FOR REPAIR TO THE EMPIRE WELL HOUSE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BROWN THAT ORDINANCE #708, IN THE AMOUNT OF:

BE APPROVED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN KAHLER AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BAILEY THAT MASTER METERS BE INSTALLED FOR HOWARD PRICE DEVELOPMENT AND ELMO BURROWS DEVELOPMENT, AND THAT THE COST OF THE METERS BE CHARGED TO PRICE AND BURROWS. ON A YEA AND NAY VOTE: ONE NAY. MOTION CARRIED.

ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO ANY FUTURE TAVERS, REQUIRED TO BE 300' FROM AN ESTABLISHED CHURCH, WAS READ TO THE COUNCIL. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH THAT THE ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED. UPON ROLL CALL VOTE, THE FOLLOWING VOTED YEA: BAILEY, DAVIES, BANKSON, HANSBRAUGH, JAY, KAHLER, BROWN, AND IATURNER. NAY: BARKER AND BOGLE. MOTION CARRIED.

ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO TRESSPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, WAS READ TO THE COUNCIL. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON THAT THE ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED. UPON ROLL CALL VOTE, THE FOLLOWING VOTED YEA: BAILEY, BANKSON, JAY, KAHLER, BARKER, DAVIES, HANSBRAUGH, IATURNER, BOGLE, AND BROWN. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BANKSON AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN IATURNER THAT MR. CLARENCE HALL BE PERMITTED A MOBILE HOME, AT THE LOCATION OF 816 SHORT STREET, TO BE APPROVED AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN JAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN IATURNER THAT THE MEETING BE ADJOURNED. MOTION CARRIED BY STANDING.
