

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 18, 1977.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT:

WARD, REED, BANKSON, HOPKINS, WADE, ALLEN, AVICOLA, MEANS.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT:

DAVIES, MURRAY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE THAT THE MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 4 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY READ ORDINANCE #892 PERTAINING TO JUNK YARDS, AUTO WRECKING YARDS OR UNSIGHTLY STORE YARDS FOR THE STORAGE OF JUNK VEHICLES OR EQUIPMENT OR SCRAP METALS.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE NAMES OF JIM TILLERSON, W. 7TH STREET AND WILLIAM WATTS, 3RD & WOOD APPLYING FOR OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TO OPERATE SALVAGE YARDS. THE MAYOR APPOINTED AVICOLA, HOPKINS AND BANKSON TO CHECK ON THE APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE IS ISSUED AND BRING RECOMMENDATION TO THE NEXT COUNCIL MEETING.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE NAME OF ROBERT E. MARTIN DOING BUSINESS AS VINYL INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS REPAIR SERVICE AT 201 DEWEY FOR A NEW OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT THE ABOVE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE BE GRANTED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO PURCHASE APPROXIMATELY \$562.57 PARTS AND SUPPLIES FOR WATER DEPARTMENT AND \$518.89 FOR METERS AND REGISTERS. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY WADE THAT PAYROLL AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 77-22 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,978.10 AND C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 77-20 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,017.52 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY HOPKINS THAT THE COUNCIL GO ON RECORD IN SUPPORT OF THE PRIDE PROGRAM. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO GIVE MARY ANN AUTHORITY TO GET EXTENSION FOR ACCEPTATION OR REJECTION ON FARMERS HOME GRANT. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE NAMES OF CARROLL HASENPLAUGH AND MICHAEL KING FOR CONFIRMATION TO THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION IF THERE IS OPENINGS ON THE COMMISSION AT THIS TIME.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT IF THERE IS OPENINGS THAT CARROLL HASENPLAUGH AND MICHAEL KING BE CONFIRMED AS MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY INSTRUCTED CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE IN LOCAL NEWSPAPER FOR BIDS ON THE REMOVAL OF TEN (10) TREES IN THE OAKHILL CEMETARY.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH A LETTER OF RESIGNATION FROM RANDY MURRAY AS COUNCIL MEMBER OF THE FOURTH WARD FOR REASON OF RESIGNATION, IS MOVING OUT OF CITY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY WADE AND SECONDED BY MEANS THAT THE RESIGNATION OF RANDY MURRAY BE ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY INSTRUCTED CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE IN LOCAL NEWSPAPER THAT THE CITY IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR COUNCIL MEMBER OF THE FOURTH WARD TO FILL UNEXPIRED TERM OF RANDY MURRAY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
