

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 2, 1976.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT:

BANKSON, BOGLE, DAVIES, HANSBRAUGH, HOPKINS, MURRAY, WARD, LEONARD.

COUNCIL MEMBERS ABSENT:

AVICOLA, MANN

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY DAVIES THAT THE MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 18 AND SPECIAL MEETING HELD OCTOBER 19 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY HOPKINS THAT THE POLICE REPORT FOR OCTOBER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$783.00 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY HOPKINS THAT (4) STEEL BELTED TIRES, FRONT END ALIGNMENT, 5 QTS. OIL AND THE EXHAUST SYSTEM ON THE POLICE CAR BE PAID FROM REVENUE SHARING AND (2) SNOW TIRES FOR THE WATER TRUCK BE PAID FROM THE WATER FUND. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY DAVIES THAT \$25.00 BE SET ASIDE AT THE FIRST OF EACH MONTH FOR EMERGENCY EXPENSES TO BE USED ONLY BY O.K. FROM DEPARTMENT HEADS OF FIRE, WATER AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY HOPKINS THAT ALL CITY COURT CASES BE HELD IN DISTRICT COURT ROOM. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH THAT C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 76-21 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,696.28 AND PAYROLL ORDINANCE 76-24 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,775.09 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY READ CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3 PERTAINING TO EXEMPTING THE CITY OF GALENA FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF K.S.A. 1974 SUPPLEMENT 12-4112, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT RELATING TO THE ASSESSMENT OF COURT COSTS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH THAT CHARTER ORDINANCE NO.3 BE ADOPTED AND THE SECOND READING WAIVED. MOTION CARRIED.

REPRESENTATIVES OF VALLEY SANATITATION SERVICE INC. WERE PRESENT AT THE MEETING AND ASK THE MAYOR TO READ A LETTER TO THE COUNCIL CONCERNING THE PICK UP SERVICE IN THE CITY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY LEONARD THAT ORDIANANCE 983 BE ENFORCED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY DAVIES THAT THE CITY ADVERTISE IN THE LOCAL NEWSPAPERS THAT THE CITY IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR CITY TREASURER TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF DON NOE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LEONARD AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ISSUE A LETTER TO FRED TITUS TO CLEAN UP HIS LOTS AT 3RD AND MAIN STREET. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH A PETITION SIGNED BY 17 CITIZENS CONCERNING MOBILE HOME PERMITS ISSUED IN THE AREA FROM 15TH STREET SOUTH TO 21ST STREET AND FROM ONE BLOCK WEST OF DEWEY STREET TO MAIN STREET, AND ASK THAT AN ORDINANCE BE DRAFTED TO PROHIBIT PERMITS ISSUED FOR ABOVE AREA.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY DRAW UP A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY OF GALENA AND WINDSOR TANK COMPANY THAT THE WINDSOR TANK CO. ASSUME ALL LEGAL EXPENSES FOR CONDEMNATION ACTION TO BE FILLED BY THE CITY OF GALENA AGAINST THE MISSOURI, KANSAS AND TEXAS RAILROAD COMPANY. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY LEONARD THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
