

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 18, 1975.

COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION, MAYOR JACK MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCILMEN PRESENT:

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH THAT THE MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 4 BE APPROVED AND PLACED ON FILE. MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH LETTERS TO SENATORS JAMES PEARSON AND BOB DOLE AND CONGRESSMAN JOE SKUBITY CONCERNING INTEREST IN THE CONTINUENCE OF REVENUE SHARING. ALL COUNCILMEN PRESENT SIGNED THE LETTERS WHICH WERE TO BE MAILED BY THE CITY CLERK.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA THAT BILL KARR BE PAID TWO WEEKS VACATION PAY IN LIEU OF VACATION. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER THAT A STREET LIGHT BE INSTALLED AT 104 EAST 22nd STREET ON THE EXISTING POLE. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY HANSBRAUGH THAT PAYROLL AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 75-25 AND C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 75-4 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY DAVIES REQUESTING THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE TO RE-ZONE ALL OF EAST 7TH STREET TO COMMERCIAL STATUS. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA FOR THE APPROVAL OF NEAL MENZIE AS BUILDING INSPECTOR EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 1975 FOR C.D.B.G. INSPECTIONS. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY AVICOLA AND SECONDED BY DAVIES TO ADOPT THE 1975 SOUTHERN BUILDING CODES FOR PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, AND BUILDING. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO PURCHASE BUILDING CODE BOOK FOR NEAL MENZIE FROM THE C.D. FUND. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY JAY AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER TO RECESS AND RECONVENE IN THE COURT ROOM FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING BIDS ON THE WATER STORAGE TANK. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY AVICOLA TO ACCEPT THE BID OF \$402,600.00 FOR A PEDESTAL TYPE TANK WHICH INCLUDES CORROSION PROOFING FROM PITTSBURGH-DES MOINES STEEL CO. MOTION CARRIED WITH ONE NAY (JAY).

MOTION WAS MADE BY JAY AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER TO ACCEPT THE BID OF \$30,397.50 FROM TRI-WAY ENTERPRISES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A WATER LINE WHICH IS TO SERVE THE SHAW HILL AREA. MOTION CARRIED.
