Motion made by Oglesby, seconded by Jackson to approve and place on file the minutes of the Galena Fire Dept. meeting, February 28, 2002. Motion declared carried

City Manager, Jack Murray stated Drawdown #6 was in the amount of \$19,113.00 and was for the lagoon project, and was to pay half of the contractor's request and some engineering fees.

City Manager, Jack Murray stated he had received a letter from the fire chief with some requests for Galena Day's June 5^{th} – 8th. Bill Shoemaker presented the commission with the plat for Triad Housing. City Manager, Jack Murray stated the commission had to approve the plat before it could be recorded.
