

MINUTES OF
GALENA CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 21, 1983.

CALL TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Galena was called to order by Mayor James Bankson, at 7:15 P.M., in the Council Chambers on Tuesday, June 21, 1983.

ROLL CALL:

Roll Call indicated the following councilmembers present: King, Little, J. Watkins, Colgrove, Allen, R. Watkins, Means. Absent: Gibson, Hayes, Murray.

MINUTES:

Moved by J. Watkins, seconded by Little, to approve and place on file the minutes of the Regular Meeting on June 7, 1983 as amended to read on paragraph 12 of page 1 "Moved by Allen, seconded by R. Watkins, to allow the Park caretaker 10 gallons of gas per week for the next 6 weeks and then allow 6-7 gallons per week." Motion declared carried.

Moved by Colgrove, seconded by King, to approve and place on file the minutes of the Special Meeting on June 14, 1983. Motion declared carried.

JOHN MASHER- RADIO
REPAIR

John Masher of JMK Electric appeared before the Council to request that he be hired to work on the radios for the City.

Chief of Police, Bill Lyerla, explained to the Council the plans for moving the police radio equipment and the dispatcher to the front counter. The cost would be around \$600. After much discussion as to how much it would cost and where the money would come from the matter was tabled.

Moved by R. Watkins, seconded by J. Watkins, to table any action on changing the radio and dispatcher to the front of the station until the July 5, 1983 meeting. Motion declared carried.

ORDINANCE #83-5
VACATING ALLEYS &
STREETS

As a result of a public hearing held prior to this regular meeting concerning the vacating of streets and alleys. Motion by Means, seconded by King, to repeal Ordinance 83-5 by resolution. Motion declared carried.

CONDEMNATIONS:

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to approve Resolution 83-11 condemning property at 608 E. 7th belonging to the Galena School District and gave them 0 days to remove. Motion declared carried.

Fred Titus requested 60 days to finish cleaning up his condemned property at 301 Main as his time had expired on the 18th. Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, that the city go ahead and clean up the property at 301 Main and charge back to Mr. Titus instead of granting him an extension and if the property at 303 Main should fall while they are cleaning up, the city would not be liable and would go ahead and clean it also. Motion declared carried. 1-nay- Colgrove, 1 -abstension - Allen.

BOB JONES - STREET
REPAIR

Bob Jones ask the council to look into paving the street on 17th Street west from Main to Dewey. This request was turned over to the Street Committee.

PLANNING AND ZONING:

Moved by Little, seconded by King, to place on file the minutes of the Planning & Zonings regular meeting on June 13, 1983. Motion declared carried.

Mrs. Mable Rosenberry's daughter, Doris, withdrew their request to have their property rezoned. They want the zoning to remain as it is.

CDBG GRANT:

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, that Bailey and Associates be hired to administer our CDBG Grant for \$21,000 to include full administration. Motion declared carried.

VACATIONS:

Moved by J. Watkins, seconded by Means, to approve 2 weeks vacation for Frankie Bartmess the first of July. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to approve 1 week pay in lieu of vacation for Jimmie Robinson and 1 week vacation from June 29 to July 6. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Means, seconded by King, to approve one week vacation for Naydene McCann from August 5 to August 13. Motion declared carried.

DUMPSTERS:

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to purchase 4 - 1 1/2 yard dumpsters for 212.00 each and 2 - 3 yard for \$372.00 each out of the Solid Waste Fund. Motion declared carried.

BALLPARK:

Moved by Means, seconded by R. Watkins, to allow the City to put in underground electrical system at the new ballpark and the additional cost will come from the Revenue Sharing. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to enter into a contract with Ed Brown for the City to dig dirt from his property and take to ballpark. Motion declared carried.

JAIL SCREEN:

Moved by Little, seconded by R. Watkins, to purchase a screen for the Jail at a cost of \$162.00. Motion declared carried.

TELE-TYPE RENTAL:

Moved by Little, seconded by Colgrove, for the City to pay \$100 rental fee to the county for the tele-type providing that Columbus, and Baxter paid their share. Motion declared carried.

ORDINANCE #83-9:

Moved by Colgrove, seconded by Little, to repeal Ordinance #1014 relating to burglary. Motion declared carried.

ORDINANCE #83-10:

Moved by Little, seconded by Means, to approve Ord. #83-10 establishing a job description for the Superintendent of Public Works. Motion declared carried.

STREET REPAIR
316 EUCLID:

Moved by J. Watkins, seconded by Allen, to allow the city to repair the street at 316 Euclid. Motion declared carried.

STREET REPAIR -
11th YALE:

Moved by J. Watkins, seconded by Colgrove, to have the City blacktop the road at 11th and Yale where needed. Motion declared carried.

HOUSING AUTHORITY
APPOINTMENT:

Moved by Little, seconded by Colgrove, to approved the Mayor recommendation to appoint Bertha Edwards to a 4 year term with the Housing Authority Board. Motion declared carried.

CLOSING STREETS FOR
MINERS DAY:

Moved by King, seconded by R. Watkins, to close Main Street between 7 A.M. and 4 P.M on Sept. 10 from 7th street to 4th street and close between 5th & 6th Main from 4-10 P.M. Motion declared carried.

Water Committee gave their May water report.

Parks Committee said the following were items needed at the Park caretakers house:

- (1) 150 ft. garden hose
- (2) 3 toilet seats
- (3) Need bathrooms pumped including house
- (4) walls need patched and painted
- (5) replace windows
- (6) needs heating system
- (7) needs cement around rock walls- boy scouts will do labor as a project

Moved by Allen, seconded by King, to buy 150 ft. hose, 3 toilet seats, windows, repair floor and and replace tile on kitchen floor, replace double wall collar on hot water tank, and buy cement for rock walls. Motion declared carried.

Street Committee: Draw up a Ordinance making land owners liable for right of way property.

BUDGET MEETING:

Moved by J. Watkins, seconded by Allen, to allow City Clerk to attend a Budget meeting in Independence June 22, 1983. Motion declared carried.

PAYROLL 83-14:


Moved by Little, seconded by J. Watkins, to approve Payroll Appropriations in the amount of \$13,061.55. Motion declared carried.
