VACATING ALLEYWAY:
ORDINANCE# 02-05

City Manager, Jack Murray stated he had spoke with Larry Cure on the Planning & Zoning Committee concerning this and he understood the Planning and Zoning had approved the placement of a mobile home on the property pending the vacating of the alley. He also had it surveyed by the city surveyor who advised there were no utilities in the alleyway and recommended vacating it.


