MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL, GALENA, KANSAS, MARCH 9, 1968

The City Council of Galena, Kansas, met March 9, 1968, at 4:30 p.m. in special meeting in the council-room at the City Hall Building.

Present: Councilmen Piercefield, Watkins, Barker, Cure, Kitch, and Pittman.

Absent: Councilman Karr.

Presiding: Mayor Frank P. Dillon.

Present also: City Attorney Yount and City Clerk Chesnutt.

The call for the special meeting wherein the object of said meeting was to discuss sewer planning problems and disposition of same was signed by Councilmen Cletis Barker, Bill Pittman, and William (Bill) Karr was read by the clerk.

Discussion was opened on the meaning of Ordinance No. 763 which authorized a special bond election for the purpose of issuing general obligation bonds for the purpose of constructing a complete sewage treatment and disposal works facility and system and for the construction of necessary main sewer lines to serve all main sections of said city.

Councilman Karr entered the council chamber and took his place at the council table.

City Attorney Yount advised the Governing Body that \$105,000 of the \$10,000 bonds to be used would be repaid by "users charge" in a manner as set forth Sections 12-630a, General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and any amendments thereto; whereas, the payment of costs of the \$305,000 of said proposed bonds would be made as provided by Sections 12-618, et seq. and 14-406 of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, and any amendments thereto.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Karr, that the city attorney be instructed to draw up an ordinance instituting a users charge (service charge) to be added and included on all water billings, wherein the customer had use of the sewer system, not exceeding a charge of \$1.50 monthly. On roll call_the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Piercefield, Watkins, β arker, Cure, Kitch, Karr, and Pittman. Nays - None.

The Governing Body agreed to meet with the Planning Commission and Oblinger and Smith, consultants for the city, on March 20, 1968 at 7 o'clock.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Karr, that the meeting be adjourned. On a show of hands the motion carried.
