Jarvis reported he had been maintaining the road for several years. Discussion was held on the possibilty of an easement, but the property owner lives in Oklahoma and will have to be contacted.

Moved by Kay Kay seconded by Anderson to table the project until contact is made with the property owner concerning an easement. Motion declared carried.

Moved by Watkins, seconded by King to adjourn the special meeting of the Governing Body. Motion declared carried.
