OBJECT BEING THAT OF PARK SUPERINTENDENT


Council meet in Special session with Mayor Murray presiding:

Councilmen present were Anderson, Bailey, Bankson, Brown, Hansbraugh, and Kaehler.

Motion by Cl. Hansbraugh, seconded by Cl. Bankson that the confirmation of Delbert Currey as Park Superintendent be withdrawn. Upon roll call vote, the motion carried with 6 Yeas!

Motion was made by Cl. Hansbraugh, that a rider be attached to the special meeting pertaining to AMBULANCE SERVICE in Galena, Kansas. Seconded by Cl. Bankson. Motion carried. Attention was called to the council that there is no ordinance in any city within Cherokee county, pertaining to ambulance service. The Mayor informed the council that The Derfelt Funeral Home, would continue ambulance service in Galena untill another ambulance service meets with the approval of the Governing body of Galena, Kansas. The clerk was informed to reply to any inquiries, that the city has no monies, with which to pay for ambulance services; and can not budget for it until next year, if then.

Motion to adjourn, was made by Cl. Kaehler, seconded by Cl. Bankson. Motion carried by standing.
