

MINUTES OF THE GALENA CITY COUNCIL, GALENA, KANSAS, MAY 14, 1968

The council of the city of Galena met in special session in the council room at the city hall at 7 p.m., May 14, 1968.

Present: Councilmen Tackett, Kaehler, Bogle, Watkins, Cure, Martin, Brown, and Pittman.

Absent: Councilmen Barker and Kitch.

Presiding: Frank P. Dillon, Mayor.

Also present: City Attorney Yount and Clerk Chesnutt.

Invocation: Mayor Dillon.

The call for special meeting to discuss sewer problems and take action on same was read by the clerk.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Tackett, that the City purchase Lots 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, and 47, Windsor Lead and Zinc Company's Addition to Empire City, now a part of the City of Galena, Kansas, from Jack Humble and Ruth Humble, his wife, and Harry B. Robeson and Frances Robeson, his wife, for a sum not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00). On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Tackett, Kaehler, Bogle, Watkins, Cure, Martin, Brown, and Pittman. Nays - none. Mayor Dillon declared the motion passed.

Councilman Cure moved, seconded by Councilman Pittman, that the Mayor and City Attorney secure an abstract for the above-mentioned lots. On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Tackett, Kaehler, Bogle, Watkins, Cure, Martin, Brown, and Pittman. Nays - none. Passage of the motion declared by the Chair.

Councilman Pittman moved, seconded by Councilman Tackett, that the Governing Body accept the grant of \$254,500 from the Economic Development Administration to be used in improvement of the existing sewer system. On roll call the vote was as follows: Yeas - Councilmen Tackett, Kaehler, Bogle, Watkins, Cure, Martin, Brown, and Pittman. Nays - none. Passage of the motion was declared by Mayor Dillon.

Councilman Tackett moved, seconded by Councilman Pittman, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried on a standing vote.
