HOWARD LITCH PROCLAMATION:

Mayor Allen stated Howard Litch had received the Governor and First Lady Award, Kansans helping Kansans, for his volunteer service to the community. He was one of 150 winners out of 1800 applications across the state for this

Moved by Qualls, seconded by Poelma, to approve a proclamation naming Howard Litch, Volunteer of the year. Motion declared carried.

BIDS ON 503 MAIN:

Mayor Allen stated two bids had been received on the building at 503 Main. G. L. Woodard Industries bid \$4200, and Lucky Miner, Inc. bid \$4250.

Moved by King, seconded by Qualls to accept the bid of Lucky Miner, Sales, Inc of \$4250 and sell the property at 503 Main to them. Motion declared carried. NAY: Poelma

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MUNICIPAL LEAGUE MEETING:

CITY WIDE RUMMAGE SALE:

Mayor Allen announced the Municipal League Meeting in Parsons, May 31 from 7:00 to 8:45 P.M. He said it was open to all council members and no registration was required.

Clyde Coleman, representing the Chamber of Commerce requested the city waive the \$1 fee for rummage and the rummage sale requirement and allow them to sponsor a city wide rummage sale on August 11, 1990. He stated this had been done in another area town, and was very successful. The chamber estimates it would put approximately \$30,000 into the economy. The chamber would require a \$5 registration fee for each and this would be used to print maps and for advertising in a 100 mile radius of Galena. The maps would then be sold. He also requested persons be allowed to register in the clerk's office and this office collect the registration fee.

Moved by Qualls, seconded by Byrd to grant a 1 day rummage sale permit to the Chamber of Commerce for August 11, waive the 2 rummage sale requirement, and allow the chamber to issue permits through the clerk's office and not sell any other permits by the city for that day. Motion declared carried.
