**ORDINANCE 98-9
RESCINDING ORDINANCE
96-10 (\$3.50 SURCHARGE):**

City attorney Mike Goodrich stated ordinance 96-10 was approved and passed by the governing body 11-5-96 providing for the collection of \$3.50 per customer per month to go for a water project

Motion made by Coleman, seconded by LaTurner to pass ordinance# 98-9 to repeal ordinance# 96-10. Motion declared carried.

RESOLUTION 97-3:

Resolution 97-3 which declared necessary to repair, alter, extend, reconstruct, and largely improve the water utility system.

Motion made by LaTurner, seconded by Coleman to rescind Resolution 97-3. Motion declared carried.

Discussion was held by the commission on incorporating increases to the city utilities. Mayor Shallenburger appointed a committee consisting of Dale Oglesby, Mark LaTurner, Cliff McQuillen, and Debbie Kitch to present to the commission at a later date recommendations of potential increases to utility rates.


ADJOURNMENT:
