MAYOR MURRAY ISSUED A PROCLAMATION TO WAVE INFORCEMENT ON CITY ORDINANCE 8-601 AND PART OF ORDINANCE 8-602 PERTAINING TO THE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS. THE SUSPENSION OF THESE ORDINANCES IS IN OBSERVANCE OF THE NATIONS 200TH BIRTHDAY, BUT MUST OBSERVE STATE REGULATIONS CONCERNING FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.
