MINUTES OF SPECIAL GALENA CITY COUNCIL MEETING

August 22, 1980

The Galena City Council met in special session Friday, August 22, 1980, at 6:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting was the hearing on the proposed 1981 Budget.

The following members answered present on roll call: Mann, Watkins, Means, R. Wade, Faulkner, Piercefield and T. Wade, constituting a quorum. Piercefield was appointed to fill the vacant council seat of Mike Hall and had signed his Oath of Office prior to the special session.

Absent from the meeting were: Kelley, Hayes and Smith.

Mayor L. G. Williams opened the session by stating the purpose of the meeting and then offering the floor to anyone who wished to speak on matters of budget.

Mrs. Beryl Powell, representing the Library Board, appeared in regard to the budget figures (\$13,315) allowed them this year, which was approximately \$5,000 less than they had requested in their proposed budget for 1981 and which the Council had approved at an earlier date.

Discussion followed on the possibility of the City bailing them out late in the year and also what fund it could be taken from.

Motion was made by T. Wade that the Clerk contact Matt Mense about the amount budgeted into the Library Fund not being as much as the Council had approved and to find out how the City can help the Library.

The Clerk is also to ask Mr. Mense if he allowed for an employee pay raise in 1981.

Piercefield seconded Wade's motion. Motion carried with 7 Yeas.

Watkins moved to accept the budget. T. Wade seconded. Motion carried.

T. Wade moved for adjournment. Watkins seconded. Carried by standing.
