

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING, SEPTEMBER 10, 1979

The governing body of the City of Galena, met in special session, Monday September 10, 1979

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss proposed trip and expenses to Washington, D.C., to meet with Congressman Whittaker and others, on the filling of mine shafts.
