

MINUTES OF
GALENA CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING, SEPTEMBER 30, 1986

CALL TO ORDER:

The Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Galena was called to order Tuesday, September 30, 1986 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers with Mayor John Stephenson presiding. RELIEF RELIEF DISPATCHER:

No action was taken concerning the relief-relief dispatcher position other than the City Clerk was asked to contact dispatcher applicants to see if they would be interested in the relief relief dispatcher position.

APCO TRAINING:

Moved by Watkins, seconded by Hayes to allow the Police Chief to attend the APCO training in Dodge City on October 5, 6, & 7, but to be back Tuesday in time for the Council Meeting on October 7. Motion declared carried.

JOPLIN ORD. 85-40:

Discussion was held concerning the ordinance adopted by Joplin which deals with juveniles cruising, loitering, and curfew.

Motion made by Kay Kay, seconded by King, to get a legal opinion from the City Attorney concerning the enforcement of the ordinance. Motion declared carried.


ADJOURNMENT:
