The state representatives were ask to come to Galena to help the city decide if it was necessary for the city to accept a Federal Grant for \$21,700 for an engineering study of which the city would have to pay \$5,430.00. The grant had been applied for through the Community Development office under Ray Randall of last year by Professional Engineers of Wichita, Kansas.
