

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF OCTOBER 21, 1971.

COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION WITH MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCILMAN PRESENT: ANDERSON BROWN BANKSON

COUNCILMAN ABSENT: BAILEY CANTRELL WASHOM

MR. C.B. SIMMONS WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING TO INFORM COUNCIL THAT FIFTEEN SETS OF SPECIFICATION SHEETS ON THE SEWER PROJECT, PHASE 3, WERE OUT TO DIFFERENT COMPANIES. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO CALL FOR THE BIDS TO BE IN BY 8 p.m. ON OCTOBER 21, 1971.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON TO ADJOURN TO THE COURTROOM FOR READING OF THE BIDS. MOTION CARRIED. MR. C.B. SIMMONS CLOSED THE TIME FOR THE BIDS AT 8:03 p.m. AND THE READING OF THE NINE BIDS ON THE PROJECT WAS BEGIN. MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN FOR 45 MINUTES FOR REVIEW OF THE BIDS. MOTION CARRIED.

MR. RICHARD MARTIN, CIVIL ENGINEER FROM HUD WAS PRESENT AT THE MEETING.

THE MEETING RECONVENED IN THE COURT ROOM AND MR. SIMMONS ANNOUNCED THE LOW BIDDER, WHICH WAS TRI CITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, 3301 E. 83rd, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI. MR. SIMMONS ALSO READ THE NEXT TWO LOW BIDS WHICH WERE, BRAYMEN MEINKING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., 321 W. CURTIS, TOPEKA, KANSAS AND BAYER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., 509 YUMA STREET, MANHATTAN, KANSAS.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN ANDERSON TO HOLD A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 1971 AT 7 p.m. TO REVIEW THE THREE LOW BIDS. MOTION CARRIED. THE CITY CLERK WAS NOTIFIED TO INFORM THE THREE ABSENT COUNCILMAN OF THE MEETING.

THE MAYOR THANKED EACH OF THE COMPANIES WHO HAD BID ON THE SEWER PROJECT.
