

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING HELD DECEMBER 30, 1975.

COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION, MAYOR MURRAY PRESIDING.

COUNCILMEN PRESENT: BANKSON, BOGLE, CHESNUTT, DAVIES, KAEHLER, LA TURNER, HANSBRAUGH.

COUNCILMEN ABSENT: AVICOLA, BARKER, JAY.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER TO TRANSFER \$2,047.33 FROM REVENUE SHARING TO THE GENERAL ACCOUNT. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LA TURNER AND SECONDED BY DAVIES THAT PAYROLL ORDINANCE 75-28 AND C.D.B.G. ORDINANCE 75-7 BE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. MOTION CARRIED.

THE FOLLOWING CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSE APPLICATIONS WE PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL:

MARIE HARDWICK- NEW PLACE- EAST 7TH STREET BAIT SHOP- WALTON SERVICE STATION
MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT THE APPLICATIONS BE ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED WITH 1 NAY (LA TURNER)

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANSBRAUGH AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT THE LOCAL TAVERNS BE ALLOWED TO STAY OPEN DECEMBER 31 UNTIL 1:30 A.M. JANUARY 1. MOTION FAILED.

A BUDGET ON THE 2ND YEAR FUNDING OF THE C.D. GRANT WAS PRESENTED TO THE COUNCIL.

MOTION WAS MADE BY BANKSON AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT \$15,000.00 BE TAKEN FROM ARCHITECTURAL FEES AND PLANNING AND ADDED TO THE \$335,000.00 FOR PAVING OF STREETS BRINGING THE TOTAL TO \$350,000.00. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY LA TURNER AND SECONDED BY BANKSON THAT THE 2ND YEAR FUNDING BUDGET ON THE C.D.B.G. BE APPROVED AS AMENDED. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY DAVIES AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER THAT MARY ANN LITTLE GET PRICES ON SOME COPY MACHINES TO BE USED IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR MURRAY PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH A CONTRACT WITH JACK'S COMMERCIAL RADIO SERVICE FOR A PERIOD OF 1 YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1976 AT THE RATE OF \$150.00 PER MONTH.

MOTION WAS MADE BY KAEHLER AND SECONDED BY BOGLE THAT COPIES OF THE CONTRACT AND A LIST OF THE CITY EQUIPMENT TO BE SERVICED BE GIVEN TO THE COUNCILMEN UNTIL JANUARY 20TH MEETING. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION WAS MADE BY KAEHLER AND SECONDED BY LA TURNER THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN. MOTION CARRIED.
