MINUTES OF CITY COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL MEETING MARCH 25, 2002

CALL TO ORDER:

The special meeting of the Galena City Commission was called to order on Thursday, March 25, 2002 at 5:00 p.m. in the commission chambers with Mayor Mark G. LaTurner presiding.

ROLL CALL:
