RESOLUTION NO. 99-15

A RESOLUTION APPROVING COST ESTIMATES OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUNICIPALLY OWNED WASTEWATER TREATMENT UTILITY SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF GALENA, CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS, BY MAKING CERTAIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND DOING ALL OTHER THINGS NECESSARY AND INCIDENTAL THERETO, AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION OF THE NOTICE OF INTENTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, TO MAKE SUCH IMPROVEMENTS AND TO ISSUE AND SELL REVENUE BONDS OF SAID CITY TO PAY PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Galena, Cherokee County, Kansas, (the "City") is a municipality as defined by K.S.A. 10-101 and 10-1201 et seq. and all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by the laws of the State of Kansas to issue and sell Revenue Bonds of the City for the improvement of its wastewater treatment utility system pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 et seq. and all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed by the Governing Body of the City to be necessary and advisable that the City improve its wastewater treatment utility system by making certain wastewater treatment system improvements including but not limited to the desludging of the lagoon cells, rip-raping dikes and installing a low pressure

Treatment Utility System Revenue Bonds of the City pursuant to K.S.A. 10-1201 et seq. and all amendments thereto in a principal amount not exceeding Three Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$355,000) to pay a portion of the costs of the improvements and to so improve said wastewater treatment utility system.

Unless written protests against such proposed improvements signed by not less than twenty percent (20%) of the qualified electors of the City are filed with the City Clerk within fifteen (15) days after the publication of this Notice, the Governing Body will proceed in accordance with the intention as set forth above to effect such improvements and will issue and sell its Wastewater Treatment Utility System Revenue Bonds as above stated.
