

RESOLUTION 26- 116

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 217 TAYLOR, IN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, IS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS AND DIRECTING THAT THE STRUCTURE BE REMOVED AND THE PREMISES MADE SAFE AND SECURE.

WHEREAS, the enforcing officer of the City of Galena, Kansas, did on or before the 02/02/2026, file with the governing body of said city, a statement in writing that the structure, herein after described, is unsafe and dangerous

WHEREAS, the governing body did by Resolution 26-04 dated the 2ND DAY OF FEBRUARY 2026, Fix the time and place of a hearing at which time the owner, his or her agent, and lienholders, any occupants and all other parties of interest in such structure could appear and show cause why such structure should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished, and provided for giving notice thereof as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution 26-04 was published in the official city newspaper on the 5TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2026. And on the 12TH DAY OF FEBRUARY 2026 and a copy of said resolution was served upon all persons entitled thereof as provided law.

Whereas, on this 2ND DAY OF MARCH, 2026, the governing body did conduct the hearing scheduled in Resolution 26-04 and took evidence of the following: the enforcing officer on behalf of the city. The following party interest, appeared did not appear.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:

1. The governing body hereby finds that the structure located at , Galena, Kansas and legally described as:
217 TAYLOR
2. The owner of such structure is hereby directed to commence the removal of the structure by April 1, 2026. Provided that upon due application by the owner and good cause show, the governing body, in its sole discretion may grant the owner additional time to complete the removal of the property.
3. If owner should not comply by April 1, 2026 the City of Galena may move forward with demolition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the owner fails to commence the removal of the structure within the time provided herein or fails to diligently prosecute the same, the governing body may take such further action as its deems necessary to raze and remove the structure without further notice to the owner or other parties interested.

BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED, THAT THE City Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published once in the official city newspaper and mail a copy to the owners, agents, lienholders, occupants and other parties in interest.
