

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 6

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 5 WITH THE REPEALING OF SECTIONS 3, 4 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 5, AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER K.S.A. 14-201 AND 14-1502.

Be It ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Galena, Kansas.

Section 1. That the City of Galena, Kansas, under Authority of Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it some of the provisions of K.S.A. 14-201 and K.S.A. 14-1502, and provide substitute and additional provisions as hereinafter set forth in this Charter Ordinance. Such statutory provisions are inapplicable to this city but not applicable uniformly to all cities.

Section 2. That Section 3, and Section 4 of Charter Ordinance No. 5 of the City of Galena, Kansas are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That the Mayor shall appoint, by and with the consent of the council, at the first regular council meeting in May of each year the City Clerk, City Attorney, Court Clerk, Building Inspector, Fore Truck Driver, and that the forsaidd appointee shall hold their offices for a term of one (1) year or until a successor is appointed. The Council shall by ordinance abolish any office created by them whenever they deem it expedient. The council may retain a professional engineer to act in teh capacity of City Engineer for specifically defined duties, and provide for reasonable compensation for ther services rendered.

Section 4. No person shall be eligible to be appointed, to any appointed office unless he or she shall become within 90 days after his or her appointment a bona fide resident of the City of Galena, Kansas or of the territory within a ten (10) mile radius of said city of Galena, Kansas and within the state of Kansas.

Section 5. That the residency requirement of Section 4 above shall not apply to anyone employed by the City which requires special training and licensing by the state.

Section 6. Section 5 shall not apply to Police Officers of the City of Galena, Kansas.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for Two (2) consecutive weeks in official city newspaper.

Section 8. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (C) (3) of the CONstitution of the State of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors voting thereon.
