**ORDINANCE NO. 13-15**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AMENDING ZONING PROVISIONS TO PERMIT CERTAIN SIGNS AND BILLBOARDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS that:

Section 1. Article 2 of Chapter 16 of the Code of the City of Galena is hereby amended to read as follows:

16-254 SAME; SIGNS. The following signs are permitted in the C-1 District:  
(a) Signs permitted in the R-1 District.  
(b) Any sign that complies with the requirements of Article 12 of Chapter 4 of the code. No business sign shall be located within 50 feet of a lot in a residential district, a public park, or a school, except that such distance limitation shall not apply to Pappy Litch Park.

16-263 SAME; SIGNS. The following signs are permitted in the C-2 District:  
(a) Signs permitted in the R-1 District.  
(b) Any sign that complies with the requirements of Article 12 of Chapter 4 of the code. No business sign shall be located within 50 feet of a lot in a residential district, a public park, or a school, except that such distance limitation shall not apply to Pappy Litch Park.

16-272 SAME; SIGNS. In an M-1 District any sign that complies with the requirements of Article 12 of Chapter 4 of the code. No business sign shall be located within 50 feet of a lot in a residential district, a public park, or a school, except that such distance limitation shall not apply to Pappy Litch Park.

16-281 SAME; SIGNS. In an M-2 District any sign that complies with the requirements of Article 12 of Chapter 4 of the code. No business sign shall be located within 50 feet of a lot in a residential district, a public park, or a school, except that such distance limitation shall not apply to Pappy Litch Park. (Ord. 82-5, Art. 2, Part 8, Sec. 4) (Ord. 10-15)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.

**ORDINANCE NO. 13-15**

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF GIRARD STREET AND VACATING ALLEYS IN A BLOCK SURROUNDED BY THE FOLLOWING STREETS: VINE STREET, BARNES STREET, GIRARD STREET, AND OAK STREET, IN GALENA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF GALENA, KANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. A portion of the platted street known as Girard Street between Vine Street and Oak Street, in Galena, Kansas, according to the recorded plat thereof, is hereby vacated and such vacation is hereby deemed necessary or expedient.

Section 2. All the platted alleys that run east to west located in the block that is surrounded by Vine Street, Barnes Street, Girard Street, and Oak Street, in Galena, Kansas, according to the recorded plat thereof, are hereby vacated and such vacation is hereby deemed necessary or expedient.

The city council hereby deems this action taken pursuant K.S.A. 14-423 and on the City Council's own motion this action is taken pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, and any amendments thereto.

Section 3 The City reserves for the City the rights for public utilities, rights-of-ways, and easements for public service facilities in existence and use.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication in the official city newspaper unless a written protest is filed in the office of the city clerk before the expiration of such time.
