

ORDINANCE NO. 82-16

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, KNOWN AS WATER STREET, BAYNE'S FIRST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GALENA: PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, and 14-423.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, IS HEREBY VACATED:

A 50 foot strip of land running East and West, and 120 feet running North and South, between Lots 6 and 7 in the Bayne's First Addition to the City of Galena, Kansas, said strip commonly known as Water Street, running North and South between 7th Street and the adjoining alley.

Vacated land will revert to owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to frontage of such real estate. Land affected by the Ordinance is 50 foot strip between Lots 6 and 7.

The City of Galena, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, can re-open said street, when the Governing Body so deems it necessary, without expense.

This Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities such right of ways and easements, that are necessary or desirable for public service.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after date of publication in the official City newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times.
