ORDINANCE NO. 82-2

AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 2-207, of the 1951 REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, FIXING THE REGISTRATION FEE REQUIRED FOR EACH DOG IN THE CITY OF GALENA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:


SECTION 1. That Section 2-207 of Article 2, Chapter II of the 1951 Revised Ordinances of the City of Galena, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The City Clerk shall charge and collect from the person causing each dog to be registered at the time of such registration the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for each dog so registered as herein required, which fee shall include the charge made for the tag to be worn by said dog and furnished to the owner by said clerk at the time of such registration. All sums so collected shall be credited to the general revenue fund of the city to meet the expense of furnishing necessary supplies and the cost and expense of administering this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That Section 2-207 of Article 2, Chapter II of the 1951 Revised Ordinances of the City of Galena, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the official City paper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
