

ORDINANCE NO. 84-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE #876 REMOVING
THE POSITION OF POLICE SERGEANT FROM BEING AN APPOINTED POSITION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance #876 is amended to read:

Officers appointed; date of appointment. The Mayor shall
at the first regular meeting of the governing body in May by
and with the consent of the council, appoint a City Marshal-Chief
of Police, Municipal Judge of the Municipal Court, City Clerk
City Attorney, Superintendent of Public Works, and may appoint
other such officers as they may deem necessary. Officers
so appointed and confirmed shall hold their offices for a term
of one year and until their successors are appointed and qualified.

SECTION 2. That section 1 of Ordinance #876 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from
and after its passage, approval and publication in the City
newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
