

ORDINANCE NO. 84-22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF MERCHANT POLICE OFFICER FOR THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 884 AND 943 IN THEIR ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: That the full-time salaried position of Merchant Police Officer for the City of Galena, Kansas is hereby and herein established. The position will be a hired position and employee will work at the discretion of the council as do all hired employees.

SECTION 2: HOURS. The Merchant Police Officers work hours shall be set by the Chief of Police of Galena. Said work hours in any event shall not be less than 40 hours per week.

SECTION 3: DUTIES AND SUPERVISION. The said Merchant Police shall be under the direction and supervision of the Chief of Police and shall guard and protect the business houses and buildings of the merchants and businessmen of the City of Galena, Kansas and will be required to watch and protect all city buildings equipment and property.

SECTION 4: It shall be the responsibility of the City of Galena to furnish:
(a) same benefits as any other full-time salaried police officer
(b) 5 gallons of gas per night
(c) uniforms and equipment.

It shall be the responsibility of the Merchant Police to furnish his own vehicle and maintain the same at his own expense.

SECTION 5: It shall be the duty of the City Clerk to receive all donations from merchants, organizations, businesses or individuals. In the event donations received shall fall below \$ 400.00 per month for a period of 3 successive months, then and in that event, this position shall be immediately reviewed by the City Council to decide whether it shall be economically feasible to continue this position.

SECTION 6: Ordinance No. 884 and No. 943 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from after its passage, approval and publication in the City newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
