

ORDINANCE NO. 84-26

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GALENA AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 83-22, ~~84-15~~, ~~84-17~~, 84-18, 84-19.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: That employees of the City of Galena, shall receive as full compensation for their services as such employees, the following amounts to-wit:

Public Works Director	1,300.00 per month
Chief of Police	1,300.00 per month
City Clerk	1,300.00 per month
Sergeant	1,075.00 per month
Asst. City Clerk	1,068.20 per month
Patrolman with School	1,037.93 per month
Patrolman without School	997.93 per month
Fire Truck Driver	986.06 per month
Cemetery Sexton	849.40 per month
Park Caretaker	805.73 per month
Merchant Police	750.00 per month
Municipal Judge	462.67 per month
Asst. Fire Truck Driver	458.33 per month
Building Inspector	424.69 per month
City Attorney	500.00 per month
Stock Marshal	402.69 per month
Janitor	371.18 per month
City Treasurer	253.30 per month
Extra Office Help	4.64 per hour
Police Dispatcher	4.64 per hour
Relief Dispatcher	4.64 per hour
School Crossing Guards	5.95 per day
(School Board pays remainder)	
Municipal Court Clerk	4.65 per hour
Asst. Superintendent	6.46 per hour
Lead Man	5.41 per hour
Wastewater Manager	5.60 per hour
Sanitation Truck Driver	5.30 per hour

SECTION 2: The above mentioned salaries show a \$50.00 a month increase for all employees except the following:

- Court Clerk & Relief Dispatcher (salary change indicates a \$.29 cent an hour increase)
- School Crossing Guard (10% increase per day)
- Temporary Employees (no increase)
- Merchant Police (no increase)
- Mechanic-Carpenter (increased to the same as operators)

SECTION 3: That the compensation provided for in this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1985.

SECTION 4: In addition to the above set ordinances salaries, employees of the City shall receive a longevity increase in the amount of one and one-half percent (1½%), of the Ordinance rate, for each year of service up to a maximum of five (5) years, beginning with the first pay period after their anniversary date.

SECTION 5: Probational employees will be paid at a rate of 25¢ an hour less, till they have worked their 90 days, EXCEPT in the condition of it being an employee that is reappointed at the annual time. Part-Time salaried employees will be hired on a 90 day probationary peirod like other employees, but will be paid regular ordinance pay - not probationary pay.

SECTION 6: Ordinance Numbers 83-22, 84-15, 84-17, 84-18 and 84-19 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City paper, The Galena Sentinel-Times & commencing with the first pay period for 1985.
