ORDINANCE NO. 84-3

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL CITY RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (.5%) WITHIN THE CITY OF GALENA, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1984.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at a special question election held on the 3rd day of April, 1984, the levying of a retailers' sales tax in the City of Galena, as authorized by K.S.A. 1981 Supp. 12-187 et seq., as amended, there is hereby levied an additional city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (.5%) to take effect on the first day of July, 1984.

SECTION 2: Except as may otherwise be provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce and collect such tax.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be published once in the official city newspaper, and a copy duly certified shall be submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
