

ORDINANCE NO. 84-9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE #1056 ESTABLISHING NEW EXPENDITURE AMOUNTS FOR THE ZELLIKEN FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:


SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance #1056 is amended to read:  
The annual interest on the aforesaid bond will be used by the Chief of Police, the Police Sergeant, or the Mayor, at their discretion, to aid and assist transients. Said expenditure shall not exceed Twenty-Five (\$25.00) for gasoline, per vehicle, or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for food per occasion. The Fund will be used until the interest is depleted. If this occurs, the Fund will be inactive until more interest is accumulated.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance #1056 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the City newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
