ORDINANCE NO. 87-14

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LOADING AND UNLOADING OF TRUCKS ON MAIN STREET IN GALENA, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 1023 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: No truck other than a pickup truck or truck of similar size legally parked, shall remain parked more than forty-five (45) minutes on the Main Street of Galena, Kansas.

SECTION 2: No truck shall park on the Main Street of Galena, Kansas so as to block the lanes of traffic or hinder the free flow of traffic from either direction.


SECTION 3: Solely for the purposes of loading and unloading a businesses and/or industrial establishments on the Main Street of Galena, Kansas, a truck may park parallel to the curb on said Main Street; provided, however, that such truck must not remain so parked for more than forty-five (45) minutes, must not block either traffic lane or hinder the free flow of traffic from either direction, and must not violate any other parking ordinance of the City of Galena, Kansas.

SECTION 4: Ordinance No. 1023 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-seven dollars (\$27.00) nor more than one hundred five dollars (\$105.00).
