

ORDINANCE NO. 88-7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 83-4 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: All committees shall be appointed by the chair, unless expressly ordered otherwise by the council. The standing committees shall consist of three members appointed annually, and the first person named on the committee shall be the chairman thereof. The following shall be the standing committees:

1. Personnel
2. Finance
3. Police
4. Fire
5. Street
6. Water
7. Parks and Cemetery
8. Sewer and Sanitation
9. Industrial
10. Insurance/Retirement
11. Health and Housing

SECTION 2: It shall be the duty of the committees hereby created to act promptly and faithfully in all matters referred to them; to make their reports orally at the regular meeting of the governing body next following such referral; and, to file in written form such reports not later than a month following said referral.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 83-4 in its entirety and any other ordinance in conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force from and after its approval and publication in the official City newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.
