

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, KNOWN AS JOPLIN STREET, WOODLAWN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF GALENA: PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, and 14-423.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, IS HEREBY VACATED:

A 250 foot strip of land running North and South, and 60 feet running East and West, between Lots 52, 53, 54, 55, and 56 on the East and 89, 90, 91, 92 and 93 on the West in Woodlawn Addition to the City of Galena, Kansas, said strip commonly known as Joplin Street, running North and South between 21st and 22nd Streets.

Vacated land will revert to owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to frontage of such real estate. Land affected by the Ordinance is a 250 foot strip between Lots 52, 53, 54, 55 and 56 on the East and 89, 90, 91, 92 and 93 on the West.

The City of Galena, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, can re-open said street, when the Governing Body so deems it necessary, without expense.

This Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities such right of ways and easements, that are necessary or desirable for public service.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after date of publication in the official City newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times.
