

ORDINANCE NO. 89-2

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE FOLLOWING ALLEY WITHIN THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, LOCATED BETWEEN EMPIRE AND OAK STREETS, WEST OF BARNES STREET TO THE WEST CITY LIMITS: PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, and 14-423.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, IS HEREBY VACATED:

A 990 foot strip of land running East and West and 20 foot running North and South between Lots 34 through 55 in Empire City Town Co's 3rd Addition and Lots 311 through 322 in Empire City on the North and Lots 103 through 114 and Lots 139 through 150 and Lots 324, 325, 28, 29, 167, and 168 in West Sub Division on the South, said strip commonly known as the alley South of Empire Street and North of Oak Street from Barnes Street West to the West City Limits.

Vacated land will revert to owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to frontage of such real estate. Land affected by the Ordinance is a 990 foot strip between Lots 34 through 55 in Empire City Town Co's 3rd Addition and Lots 311 through 322 in Empire City on the North and Lots 103 through 114 and Lots 139 through 150 and Lots 324, 325, 28, 29, 167, and 168 in West Sub Division on the South.

The City of Galena, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, can reopen said alley when the Governing Body so deems it necessary, without expense.

The Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities such right of ways and easements, that are necessary and desirable for public service.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of publication in the official City newspaper, the Galena Sentinel Times.
