ORDINANCE NO. 89-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE SPECIAL WATER FUND TO BE USED TO PAY FOR WATER LINES FROM 23RD STREET TO SCHERMERHORN PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:

Section 1: The Special Water Fund set up by Ordinance No. 1057 shall be used to pay for the installation of a water line on the East side of Main Street from 23rd Street to Schermerhorn Park and on the West side of Main Street from 24th Street to Schermerhorn Park.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 1057 is repealed to the extent inconsistent herewith.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

Passed by the Governing Body and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of January, 1989.
