ORDINANCE NO. 89-4

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STANDARD BUILDING CODE FOR THE CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: There is hereby adopted by the city council of the city, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, removal, demolition, equipment, use and occupancy, location and maintenance of buildings and structures, including permits and penalties, that certain building code known as the Southern Building Code Congress International, Incorporated, being particularly the 1988 edition thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as hereinafter deleted, modified, or amended, of which no fewer than three copies of said code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Galena," and shall be filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours of business.

SECTION 2: Any person violating any provision of the aforesaid code shall be punished as provided in Section 1-111 of the Code of the City of Galena.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall replace and repeal Section 4-201 of the Code of the City of Galena.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
