

ORDINANCE NO. 89-7

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE CITY TO PAY ITS SHARE OF THE COST OF EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE AND LIFE INSURANCE FROM THE EMPLOYEE BENEFITS CONTRIBUTION FUND AND TO SET THE FUND LEVY AT AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA THAT:

SECTION 1: The liability of the city for premiums on employee health insurance and life insurance may be paid from the Employee Benefits Contribution Fund.

SECTION 2: The governing body is hereby authorized to levy an annual tax upon all taxable tangible property within the taxing subdivision in an amount determined by the governing body to be necessary for the purposes of the fund.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
