ORDINANCE NO. 89-8

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE KEEPING OF DOGS AND CATS IN THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA THAT:

SECTION 1: Anyone operating a kennel shall be subject to the following:

- A. Said person shall pay an annual registration fee to the City in the amount of \$50.
- B. Said fee shall be due and paid before the fourth dog or cat is acquired.
- C. The dogs shall be kept in a fenced area with proper shade, ventilation, food, and water; the fence shall be at least four feet tall and of sturdy construction; the fenced area shall be kept clean of animal waste; and the fenced area shall not be within two hundred feet of any human habitation without the written consent of the people dwelling therein.
- D. A person shall be considered to operate a kennel if the person has on the premises four or more cats at least one month of age or a combination of four or more of said cats and dogs and has received any income or compensation in the previous twelve months from selling or boarding or otherwise dealing in cats and dogs.

SECTION 2: All cats over three months of age and all dogs over one month of age shall be registered with the city clerk.

SECTION 3: The animal control officer shall dispose of dead dogs, cats, and other small animals upon request by the owner and the payment of a fee of \$10.

SECTION 4: The animal control officer shall dispose of live dogs, cats, and other small animals upon request by the owner and the payment of a fee of \$25.

SECTION 5: The owner of any dog or cat impounded by the city may redeem said animal upon paying a fee of \$10. upon the first impoundment, \$20 upon the second impoundment, and \$40. upon the third impoundment, plus \$5. for each day the animal was held by the city. Upon a fourth impoundment, the animal shall be destroyed and the owner shall be billed \$25.

SECTION 6: Anyone violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$30 and not more than \$100 for each separate offense.


SECTION 7: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official city newspaper.
