

ORDINANCE 90-1

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE 89-1 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA:

SECTION 1: That employees of the City of Galena, shall receive as full compensation for their services as such employees, the following amounts to-wit:

SECTION 2: That the above set longevity increase shall be added for each year of service up to a maximum of five (5) years, beginning with their first pay period following their anniversary date, and excludes any employee hired after January 1, 1987.

SECTION 3: Upon a change in the Federal Minimum Wage rate, all seasonal employees will be paid at the Federal Minimum Wage Rate.

SECTION 4: The first compensation provided for in this ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1990.

SECTION 5: Probational employees will be paid at a rate of 25¢ per hour less than ordinance rate, until they have worked 90 days, EXCEPT IN THE CONDITION OF IT BEING AN EMPLOYEE THAT IS REAPPOINTED AT THE ANNUAL TIME. Part-time salaried employees will be hired on a 90 day probationary period like other employees, but will be paid regular ordinance pay, not probationary pay.

SECTION 6: Ordinance Number 89-1 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 7: All city employees except seasonal are granted a 3% pay increase for 1990. Any person employed by the city on January 1, 1990 who leaves the city's employment during 1990 will receive an additional 2% of their gross pay to date with their final check. Raises for 1991 will be 7%.

SECTION 8: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City Newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times and commencing with the first pay period of 1990.
