

ORDINANCE 90-11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CONTAINER REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR REFUSE COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF GALENA AND REPEALING CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 15.302a OF THE CITY CODE IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS:


SECTION 1: The governing body does hereby establish the following container requirements for refuse collected by the City of Galena.

RESIDENTIAL AREAS: It shall be the duty of every person in possession, charge, or control of any place, premise, building, or structure from which garbage or refuse accumulates to provide suitable containers for holding such garbage or refuse, such as plastic or galvanized metal containers approximately 40 gallons or less in capacity or plastic bags. All containers weight not to exceed 75 pounds when full. Plastic bags weight not to exceed 40 pounds when full. Non-standard containers will not be picked up.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance repeals Chapter 15, Article 3, Section 15.302a of the City Code of the City of Galena, Kansas, and any other sections in conflict herewith.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance will be in full force from and after its approval and publication in the official city newspaper, the Galena Sentinel-Times.
