

ORDINANCE 90-12

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH BETWEEN VINE AND SPARKS STREETS IN EMPIRE, EAST OF JOPLIN STREET AND WEST OF JEFFERSON STREET WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-512A, 12-506, and 14-423 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 90-9 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GALENA, KANSAS THAT THE REAL ESTATE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS IS HEREBY VACATED.

A 270 foot strip of land running North and South and 20 feet East and West between Lots 58 and 67 located in Empire City Town Company's 1st Addition to Empire (now Galena) and Lots 75 and 77 located in Empire City Town Company's 4th Addition to Empire (now Galena).

Vacated land will revert to owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to frontage of such real estate. Land affected by this Ordinance is Lots 58 through 67 in Empire Town Company's 1st Addition to Empire (now Galena) and Lots 75 and 77 of Empire City Town Company's 4th Addition to Empire (now Galena), all in the City of Galena, Kansas.

The City of Galena, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 14-423, can reopen said alley when the Governing Body so deems it necessary without expense.

This Ordinance reserves to the City and public utilities such right of ways and easements, that are necessary and desirable for public service.

This Ordinance repeals Ordinance Number 90-9 in its entirety.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after the date of publication in the official City newspaper, The Galena Sentinel-Times.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 1st day of May, 1990.
